



Admission of Companions

A person shall only be admitted as a Companion if he/she:-

- 1 is not engaged in the craft of organ building but must have declared themselves interested in supporting the aims of the Society and is not eligible for membership under any previously mentioned membership grade; and
- 2 accepts that a Companion is not a grade of membership of the Society and therefore has no voting rights whatsoever nor may they use letters relevant to the Society following their name, nor make use of the Society logo. They may however call themselves "Companion of the ISOB"; and
- 3 is sponsored by a Fellow, Counsellor, Associate or Ordinary Member of the Society; and
- 4 is accepted by the Council as a Companion.

Companions will be entitled to attend any meetings of the Society as a guest, and receive any publications produced by the Society. They shall have no access to the "Members only" section of the Website.

Persons admitted as Companion shall pay £30.00 per annum
